


Philippe and Diane Cauvin teamed up in 2006 to take over the



15 hectares of vines of this historic property in Villaudric with a purely viticultural vocation for several centuries.


Surrounded by woods and vineyards in the Fronton AOC, the



The vineyard consists of several plots with pebble terroirs, clay, sand, and regional grape varieties.



Aware of this potential, attracted by common sense, farming practices and wishing to offer their children a healthy environment, they immediately convert their vineyard to biodynamic according to simple qualitative principles:



- diversity and value of identity grape varieties
- soil work and balance
- parcels selection
- respectful pruning and controlled yields
- manual and sorted harvest,
- natural winemaking and soft extractions,
- patience and ...lots of love...



The estate continues its development towards heritage grape varieties, like Negret Pounjut and Malbec, offering a complete and original range around the Negrette grape variety and continuing the grafting of the rare white Bouysselet to experiment with other wine profiles.



Slow tourism and wine tourism also play an important role in communicating about the wines and enhancing the place thanks to a Gîte Vigneron and a Chai de Réception, in bricks and pebbles, that can accommodate groups of tasting, varied cultural events and private family receptions.



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
